The First Tee of Phoenix Adult Code of Conduct

In order to uphold the goals of The First Tee of Phoenix and ensure that all participants have the benefit of a safe and fun learning environment, all parents, guardians and other adults and attendees of The First Tee of Phoenix events must behave accordingly in a respectful, courteous and sportsmanlike manner at all times. Please read the following and sign where indicated to show your understanding of The First Tee of Phoenix Adult Code of Conduct.

Any adult who is using alcohol, tobacco or nonprescription drugs and/or appears intoxicated at an event associated with The First Tee of Phoenix, and/or who is flagrantly rude, attempts to intimidate, verbally abuses, heckles, taunts, ridicules, boos, throws objects and/or uses vulgarity or profane language/gestures with a coach, volunteer, staff member, participant or other event attendee, will receive a verbal warning and/or be asked to leave The First Tee of Phoenix event. The First Tee of Phoenix may also provide a written warning to the individual regarding the misbehavior. The adult's children may also be removed from the event.

Any adult who commits one of the above stated offenses a second time, will be banned from all events associated with The First Tee of Phoenix for a period of one year from the date of the second offense, and his/her children may also be removed from the program for that time period.

Any adult who physically assaults a coach, volunteer, staff member, participant, or other event attendee or threatens bodily harm may be banned from all events associated with The First Tee of Phoenix for one year from the date of the offense, and his/her children may also be removed from the program for that time period.

After the ban has expired, if the individual commits another offense, the individual will be permanently banned from all events associated with The First Tee of Phoenix and the individual's children may be permanently removed from the program.

An adult who has a concern or suggestion regarding The First Tee of Phoenix should voice his/her recommendation to a staff member.

The First Tee of Phoenix Participant Behavior Policy

The First Tee participants are expected to behave in a way that does not interrupt the education of other students, or endanger other students or themselves. Violence, indecent language, disrespect to coaches, disruptive behavior and other improper conduct are not permitted. Appropriate behavior is expected from all participants and observers in programs and in facilities to protect the enjoyment and safety of all.

- First Offense – participant will be warned that he/she is behaving in an inappropriate manner.
- Second Offense – participant will be asked to sit out for the remainder of the class session and his/her parent or guardian will be notified.
- Third Offense – participant will be placed on 1 month probation in which he/she may only attend classes when his/her parent or guardian is present.
- Fourth Offense – participant will be suspended from all programming for a period of 3 months. A conference will be held with parent and child before return to program.

The First Tee of Phoenix grants all staff members the authority to enforce this policy is at his/her discretion.
